Registration:

Frequently Asked Questions:

What if I'm late to class?

The instructors are not allowed to admit late students. You will need to register and pay again for another class.

What if I miss my class?

If you miss a class without prior approval, you will need to register and pay again.

Do I have to go back to court to turn in my Certificate of Completion?

If you signed a Plea agreement at New Hanover County or Pender County traffic court, and our office has a current copy, we will deliver documents and any applicable court fees to the court for you.

What if I can't bring the court fees to class?

If you come to class without your money order or cashier's check for New Hanover or Pender County court fees, we will give you your Plea agreement and Certificate of Completion at the end of class. You will be responsible for turning it in before your court date.

What if there are no available classes before my court date?

You will need to go back to traffic court on your court date and ask for your date to be continued so you have more time to take the class.
